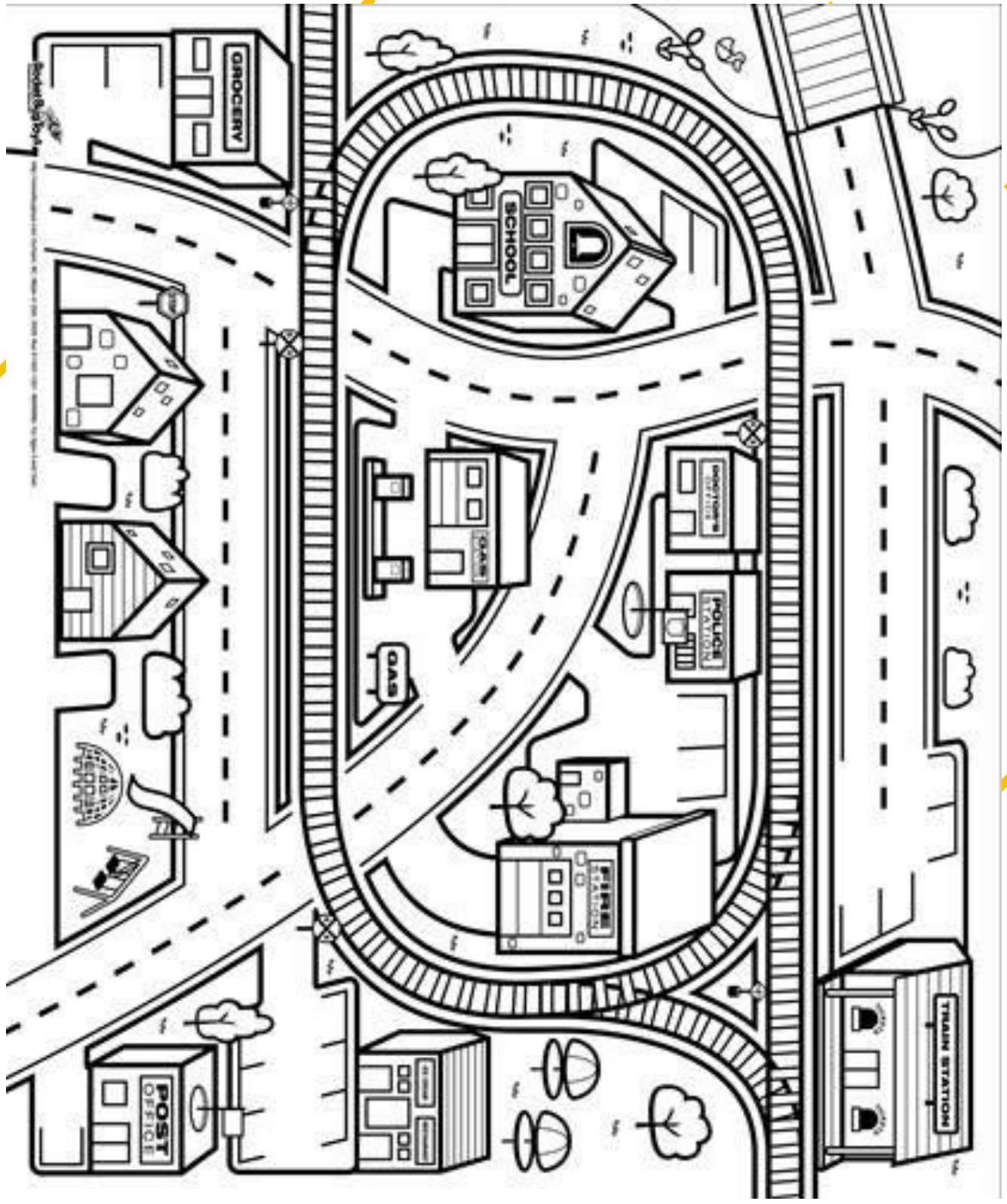

STORIES OF HOPE: THE PRODIGAL SON. LUKE 15:11-32

COLOUR. In her talk today, Amy tells us the lost, or prodigal son “changed lanes” only to discover it wasn’t a “good lane”. He went back to his father and found love and forgiveness which allowed him to change direction, back into a “good lane”. Print and colour in the road map on page 2 and write on it, “ Luke 15:11-32. The Lost son....changed direction”

MAKE. Follow the instructions on page 3 to create a peg racing car as a reminder of the message of today’s talk. When we repent, or change direction we always find God’s love and forgiveness

PUZZLE: Print out and complete the coded word puzzle on page 4 (the answers are on the next page if you are stuck– but don’t cheat!!!)The puzzle is, of course, linked to today’s bible story.

Peg Racing Car



You will need: pegs, pipe-cleaners (or wire bread tags) 4 buttons.

1. Thread the pipe-cleaners through the peg as shown in the picture opposite.
2. Next, thread 4 buttons onto each end the pipe-cleaner. Then, thread it back through the other hole in the button and then secure the two ends of the pip-cleaner together with a little twist. Trim off any left-over pipe-cleaner.
3. If you have a wooden peg and you are feeling super creative –decorate your peg using sharpie pens/felt tips. You can even add googly eyes if you have some at the bottom of your craft box.
4. You are all done!! You can race your car around your colouring page or pop it somewhere to remind you that the “prodigal” son in today’s bible story, “changed lanes.”
