PERSEVERANCE : HOW TO FIND A RAINBOW IN A STORM

THE STORY OF PAUL— ACTS 9 3-18

CREATE: Over the lockdown a lot of children and their families were involved with creating a rainbow and displaying this in their window. These were signs of hope during a stormy time. Paul trusted in God even when he was "going through a storm" and the rainbow can be a sign of a promise. To remember this we have a rainbow colouring in sheet and a thankful jar.
