COLOUR. Today is remembrance Sunday. Colour in the page 2 and as you colour, pray for those in God's world who are affected by war and unrest. Pray too for those who continue to serve around the world.

MAKE. Follow the instructions on page 3 to create a paper plate or plastic bottle poppy. When it's finished why not put them up in your window and make a remembrance day display.

ACTIVITY: On remembrance day we remember those who serve and keep us safe. Sadly we also remember those who lost their lives doing so. On page 4 is a poem about remembrance. Why not say this together with everyone in your household. On page 5 is a dove. Doves are a symbol of peace. Why not hang this up in your window along with your poppies, as a reminder of God's peace in troubled times.





Let's make a poppy



You will need: A paper plate, plastic bottle, red and black paint and scissors

Paper Plate Poppy

1. Take a paper plate and cut out a poppy shape. Next, paint the middle of the plate black and the rest of it red.
2. Repeat the process a few times to make a window display of remembrance



Pop Bottle Poppy

1. with the help of a grown up, cut off the bottom of a pop bottle.
2. Paint inside of the bottle starting with a black centre. Continue to paint the red petals to complete your poppy.
3. Add these to your remembrance display...well done
