Dear friends.

What a glorious welcome you've offered to us as a family as we've arrived in the Stoke-on-Trent Mission Circuit. Thank you so very much for making each of us feel at home so very quickly. I have no doubt, after only a week, that I'm going to deeply enjoy my work here, but equally, I expect to face some real challenges, not least in getting to learn some of the 'Stokie' nuances!!



My 11 years of ministry has been interesting, from my initial 5 years on the Wirral, 18 months of which was on maternity leave, to my last 6 years as the Superintendent of the Market Drayton Circuit. My early years as a teacher have obviously left an impact, as I have found myself always being drawn back towards school in some ways, whilst never actually achieving it! Latterly, that was in my responding to a call I felt to school chaplaincy. Last October, I successfully applied for a school chaplaincy job in a Methodist independent school, and so we had been planning to move to that appointment. Sadly, that position fell through which left us needing to leave an appointment as it had already been filled, but with none to go to.

But, God is good. I know this because within 3 weeks by His grace and the wonderful and hard work of some human hands, this appointment became not only possible, but something that I believe to be absolutely the 'right' thing. Now that isn't to say that the other was wrong, but rather an acknowledgement of the absolute truth of the scriptures that we know and love about God's plans, and God working for our good and never for our ill.

Out of what was, quite honestly a deeply upsetting situation, He has brought about something that is better than we could have asked or imagined. And isn't that just the truth of God's story? He has never promised to shield us from the pain and challenges of this world, but He has always reminded us of His faithfulness in it all. Which is why my motto during these past few months, even in the midst of deep uncertainty for us as a whole family has been... "It's ok. God's got this."

We look forward to getting to know you and working with you all as we share God's amazing story and piece by piece, heart by heart, life by life, building God's Kingdom right where we are.
